



Yi Hyderabad Chapter support for AP Flood Relief

Yi Hyderabad Chapter has made an appeal to all its members to Support the Flood Relief Activity in Andhra Pradesh. Members have come forward to generously contribute for this cause. The Chapter members have already contributed around Rs 60,000 and more members are coming forward to join this cause. Amara Raja Batteries has also contributed Rs. 50 lakh to the CM Relief Fund. One of the members has personally distributed 10 tonnes of Rice to the Krishna District.

On 11th of October also the students visited the Guntur & Krishna districts and distributed food & other essential commodities to the flood victims.
